

****Thornbury Yacht Club Haul-Out 2018****

Haul-Out will start at 0800 hrs, Friday, Oct 12, 2018 and at 0800 hrs, Sunday, Oct 14, 2018

Similar to Launch Day, please park on the river/east and bay/north side of the road.

- 1.** Per environmental regulations, there will be no power-washing until the weekend following Haul-Out.
- 2.** Please ensure your cradle is ready to go. The posts are upright, bolts fastened and the pads installed, possibly greased to allow for easy movement. If you are using stands ensure you have the necessary chains to lock them in place. It is also your responsibility to provide any wood blocking that is needed.
- 3.** Attach two **50'** lines on one side at the bow and the stern, for the crane crew.
- 4.** Each owner is expected to be present, or arrange for an alternate, to help out. All members should check in with the Co-ordinator well in advance of the estimated time.
- 5.** The Haul-out sequence within each group or otherwise may be decided/changed by the crane operator or the TYC Co-ordinator.
- 6.** Owners or agents are responsible for lift strap locations. Sling markers are extremely beneficial at Haul Out. Please mark your boat accordingly prior to.
- 7.** Please clearly identify your boat and cradle with the boat's name, owner's name, bow & stern.
- 8.** If your mast is in the up position on your boat and your backstay needs to be removed for Haul-out, ensure you have the halyards set and be ready to go before your turn.
- 9.** For safety reasons, no one will be allowed in, on or under the boat during Haul-out. Members are reminded that for reasons of safety and work effectiveness children under 14 and pets are not allowed within 100 feet of the crane.
- 10.** One crew will assist on the dock and the other crew at the boat cradle location.
- 11.** Hard hats are recommended. It is strongly recommended that 'shore-based' work crews wear safety boots/shoes with steel toes.
- 12.** Provide the Co-ordinator with your preference for the positioning of your boat (Bow/stern direction)
- 13.** If for any reason you need to leave the Haul-out area, provide the Co-ordinator with a cell number at which you can be reached. The Haul-out order may change at short notice.
- 14.** All hands on deck, means no winter prepping your boat until all the boats have been hauled.

Please remember that the TYC is a volunteer club, and your assistance through the day will ensure a safe and timely Haul-Out.
