

## **\*\*Thornbury Yacht Club LAUNCH 2017\*\***

### **Launch will start at 0800 hrs, Sunday May 14, 2017**

- 1.** Per environmental regulations, there can be no bottom painting on launch day. Any boat with fresh paint will not be launched.
- 2.** Please make sure that your cradle is folded down flat and that all ladders, pads, block AND ANY REMOVABLE POSTS etc. are removed. The cradles will be organized and stacked on Launch day – please come prepared to fold your cradle on Sunday. Cradles will be moved on Monday morning.
- 3.** Environmental regulations also require that we do not discharge antifreeze into the lake. We therefore have to collect antifreeze from our engines prior to launch. Containers for collection of antifreeze are available at the harbour so please see Ryan Gibbons if you have any questions
- 4.** Each owner is expected to be present, or arrange for an alternate, to help out on their assigned work party. The Work Party/Launch schedule will be issued shortly. All members should check in with their work party captain well in advance of the estimated time. All owners are expected to help for the full duration of their work party shift. As in past years, the large crane will start at the North end of the Bay side, and the smaller crane will work from the washroom end on the riverside. The large crane will move to the riverside after finishing on the Bay side.
- 5.** The launch sequence within each group may be decided by the crane operator.
- 6.** Attach 40 foot dock lines to the bow and stern
- 7.** Owners or agents are responsible for lift strap locations. Sling markers are extremely beneficial at Haul Out. Please mark your boat accordingly prior to launch.
- 8.** Please clearly identify your boat and cradle with the boat's name, owner's name, bow & stern. Cradles must be folded by end of day Sunday. Only folded flat and clearly labeled cradles will be moved to the storage area on Monday morning.
- 9.** For safety reasons, no one will be allowed in, on or under the boat during the actual launch. Members are reminded that for reasons of safety and work effectiveness children under 14 and pets are not allowed within 100 feet of the crane.
- 10.** Crew Chiefs will be responsible for organizing the duties for their work party. As a general rule, one crew should assist on the dock and the other crew at the boats being launched. Each Crew Chief will be wearing a fluorescent safety vest.
- 11.** Hard hats are recommended. It is strongly recommended that 'shore-based' work crews wear safety boots/shoes with steel toes.

Please remember that the TYC is a self-help club, and your assistance through the day will ensure a safe and timely launch.
